Terms of Reference (ToR) for empanelling regional technical team / Technical Advisory Group / consultant for Value Chain Strengthening and Partnership

I. Introduction

Vaazhndhu Kaattuvom Project (VKP) is an innovative World Bank assisted Project that aims at rural transformation through strategies that look beyond poverty alleviation by building sustainability and prosperity of rural communities through rural enterprise promotion, access to finance and employment opportunities in the selected blocks of Tamil Nadu. The Project will build on existing institutional capital and investments made by TNEPRP, TNSRLM and NRLP. The Project is implemented in 120 blocks covering 3,994 village panchayats spread across 31 districts of Tamil Nadu.

In order to promote rural enterprises the component rural enterprise ecosystem development facilitate,

- identification and prioritize commodities/ subsector for project interventions and investments through inclusive strategy and value chain analytical approach by carrying out a series of activities namely District Diagnostic studies, Value Chain Analysis and Participatory Growth Plan.
- Developing appropriate institutions and mechanism for providing business development support services through One Stop Facility with the aid of Enterprise Community Professionals to enterprises in initiating, managing, and successfully running their business.
- Promote individual and collective enterprises along prioritized sub sectoral value chain activities and enhance the capacity of these players to engage with the market and other stakeholders effectively.

II. Implementation Arrangement

The component Rural Enterprise Ecosystem Development in State Project Management Unit (SPMU) is led by Associate Chief Operating Officer (ACOO), Deputy Chief Operating Officer and Young Professionals guided by the Chief Executive Officer and Chief Operating Officer. Project team both at district level and block level implements project activities of promoting both individual and growth enterprises.

III. Enterprise Development and Enterprise Promotion

The project through its inclusive strategic analytics investment planning tool fosters and facilitate rural enterprise promotion as follows,

- District Diagnostic Study (DDS) is an exercise/process of gathering and analysing information and secondary data around district for prioritising potential commodities/sub sectors and Value Chain Analysis (VCA) is to deep dive into the prioritized commodities/subsector identified for understanding opportunities, challenges and risks.
- Participatory Growth Plan (PGP) A participatory exercise for developing and identifying project interventions and investment for enterprise promotion and strengthening and thereby developing an inclusive investment plan.
- Enterprise Group (EG) a group of 10-30 members having joint ownership and control over the business activities with shared profit and Loss.
- Producer Group (PG) a group of 30-150 producers engaged in a particular commodity / subsector in a village who come together for aggregation, productivity enhancement, and other collective actions.
- Producer Collective (PC) a formal higher-level collective of 300-3000 producers for aggregation, value addition, marketing and service provisioning for economies of scale.

IV. Need for Consultant

• The VKP project is looking for a pool of consultants/Technical Advisory Group members (5 consultants per VKP project region) with relevant experience, technical skill set and expertise in Farm, Off- Farm and Non – Farm sectors. The consultant would be responsible for providing strategic handholding support to the VKP team (at state/ district/ block level depending on need), the supported community organisations (PG/EG/PC) as well as individual entrepreneurs on specific commodity/ subsector as per ones own specialisation across different domains of the value chain, namely pre-production, production and post production.

The skill sets of the consultants should be around one or multiple themes which are articulated below,

- Diagnostics of the issues and challenges in the commodities / subsectors and prescribing ways forward to enhance producers/ entrepreneurs income.
- Developing technical training module for the relevant portion of the value chain as applicable and impart training to individual and collective enterprises.
- Support collective and individual enterprises to adopt the practices.
- Handhold the project team to ensure adoption of process and technology at the community level.
- Help the collectives and individual enterprises in proper functioning and running of installed machinery.
- Help the collectives and individual enterprises in various level of commodity processing and also bringing in process efficiency.
- Support in packaging and branding of the produce of the collective and individual enterprise.
- Support in marketing of produce and processed outputs (bulk market, retail market, B2B, B2C as well as in e-commerce)
- Support in understanding consumer preference and help the collective and individual enterprises to place their products accordingly.
- Support the collectives and individual enterprises in financial management, book keeping, auditing, legal compliances, etc.,
